

# WHERE SHOULD I APPLY TO RECEIVE THE COVID-19 VACCINE?

- ▶ Check whether you are eligible for the COVID-19 vaccine by logging in the e-Nabız application.
- ▶ In order to find out your eligibility status by text message (SMS), you can type "AŞI", and your Turkish ID Number and the last 4 digits of your Turkish ID Serial Number respectively by leaving a space between each of them, and send a text message (SMS) to 2023. (E.g. AŞI 12345678910 1234)
- ▶ If you are in the group to be vaccinated, make an appointment for the vaccination via the Central Physician Appointment System (MHS web, MHS mobile) or e-Nabız. To minimize the risk of contact, please do not apply to the healthcare facility without an appointment.

## ► HOW ARE COVID-19 VACCINE PRIORITY GROUPS DETERMINED?

Priority order for the groups to receive the COVID-19 vaccine have been determined by evaluating the risk of exposure to the disease, the risk of having the disease with a severe course and the risk of transmitting the disease, and the negative impact of the disease on the functioning of social life. The vaccine will be administered to these groups in order of priority accordingly.

## ► I RECEIVED THE PNEUMONIA AND/OR FLU VACCINE, DO I NEED TO RECEIVE THE COVID-19 VACCINE AS WELL?

Pneumonia (pneumococcal) and flu (seasonal influenza) vaccines do not protect against COVID-19.

Therefore, in order to be protected against COVID-19, administration of the vaccine specifically developed against COVID-19 is necessary.

## ► I HAVE RECENTLY RECEIVED THE FLU AND/OR PNEUMONIA VACCINE, CAN I RECEIVE THE COVID-19 VACCINE?

You can receive the inactivated COVID-19 vaccine at least 2 weeks after the flu and/or pneumonia vaccine.



## ► WHERE IS THE COVID-19 VACCINE ADMINISTERED, IS IT PAID?

COVID-19 vaccines will be administered in all healthcare facilities that normally provide vaccination services, primarily in Family Health Centers.

Vaccination services will be provided by teams within Community Health Centers/District Health Directorates for those staying in elderly nursing homes, rehabilitation centers for the disabled, protection homes, and those who provide services in these centers.

The vaccinations of the persons registered in the home health care system will be carried out by the health personnel who are authorized to administer the vaccine.

The vaccines provided by the Turkish Ministry of Health will be administered free of charge.
